FISHING RULES AMMENDED 2002

1. **Fishing is only to take place within the times and limits laid down by the organisers.**
- 2 Fishing will be with rod, reel, and line only.
3. (a) Participants in all Club outings may fish with only one rod fully fitted up. (*Spare rods and reels over and above these may be assembled; the running line threaded through the rod rings and attached to a swivel or link, but no end tackle of hooks, hook lengths or sinkers may be fitted.*)
(b) Drilled bullets or any weight acting as a drilled bullet for the purpose of cocking or setting a float, which is to be attached to the running (or main) line above the swivel or link is defined as non end-tackle.
4. Rods shall have a minimum length of 1.52m (5ft). The maximum length for boat fishing will be 3.04m (10ft). There is no maximum length for shore fishing.
5. Hydraulic, electric and double-handed reels are not permitted.
6. The running line is to be not to be more than 80lbs breaking strain for multi- strand types (Dacron, etc.), and not more than 0.75mm diameter for monofilament types (this does not apply to events designated as special events, e.g. for Tope, Conger, Skate, Shark and Halibut)
7. The maximum of three (3) single hooks may be used, except in boat matches, where a maximum of one (1) hook may be imposed at certain outings, by the Committee, with a prior announcement to all Club members. (At matches where a one (1) hook rule has been imposed, it may, after consultation among all present, be rescinded for either the whole match or part thereof. The final decision however shall rest with the Boat Convenor) a treble hook counts as three (3) hooks and a double hook counts as two (2) hooks.
8. Artificial lures may be of any type and size, but may only be fitted with hooks not exceeding 6/0 in size.
9. The deliberate foul hooking of fish is not permitted; however, accidental foul hooked fish will be eligible for weigh-in. If a fish is hooked by two anglers, the angler with the hook in the fish's mouth may weigh-in the fish. If both anglers have hooked the fish in the mouth or in the body, the fish will not count for weigh-in.
Fish retrieved on lost traces, will not be eligible for weighing in.
10. Anglers may receive the help of others to gaff or lift a fish.
11. The rod is not to be rested on boat gunwales, capstans or rod seats, etc, while playing a fish. Hand lining is only permitted when the terminal trace can be used for that purpose.
- 12 (a).Members with physical handicaps may receive help in casting, provided they obtain permission in writing from the organisers prior to the event.
(b) Due recognition of a members *known existing physical handicap* of whatever nature should be acknowledged, by allowing them where necessary (should it be felt it would possibly aggravate their handicap due to access or otherwise of the mark or area being fished, and with the knowledge and agreement of the Shore Convener) to fish outwith the immediate area designated as the boundary, (this also to be limited by boundaries), at the discretion of the Shore Convener.
13. That for all shore venues the Club Members will be told of the boundaries for each match beforehand where possible.
14. In the interest of fairness, where possible, shore matches should be pegged at the discretion of the Shore Convener.
- 15 In the interests of safety and conservation, all lesser spotted dogfish and spurdog, when not being kept for the table, should be returned to the water alive.
At Shore Matches:
Lesser spotted dogfish shall be allocated a weight of 0.8kgs per fish.
Spurdog shall be allocated a weight of 1.75kgs per fish.

All tope should be weighed and returned to the water immediately after capture. Provision should be made by the Shore Convenor for the weighing and recording of all fish, be they returned or retained. The weighing and return of other species of fish will be at the discretion of the Shore Convenor on the day.

At Boat Matches all fish shall be weighed.

16. Any member who leaves litter behind, or disposes of litter incorrectly at any Club outing (boat or shore) will forfeit all points gained at that outing.
Any reported incident of the above must be corroborated by two or more members.
17. Contravention of any of these rules may result in disqualification.
18. **THE SILVER LURE S.A.C. BOAT AND SHORE CHAMPIONSHIP-POINTS SYSTEM**
Points will be awarded on a percentage basis, the angler taking the winning bag at a match being awarded one hundred (100) points. All other anglers weighing in will be awarded points as a percentage of the aforementioned winning bag, their points to be rounded up or down to the nearest whole point.
